Tourne's unique, patented Dream4 system allows a standard van to sleep up to four people. The kitchen is a compact and practical full-time real working kitchen. Similarly, the WC/shower is all function and convenience. And Tourne's integrated system heating combined with insulated cabin ensures you'll stay warm and comfortable, whatever the weather.

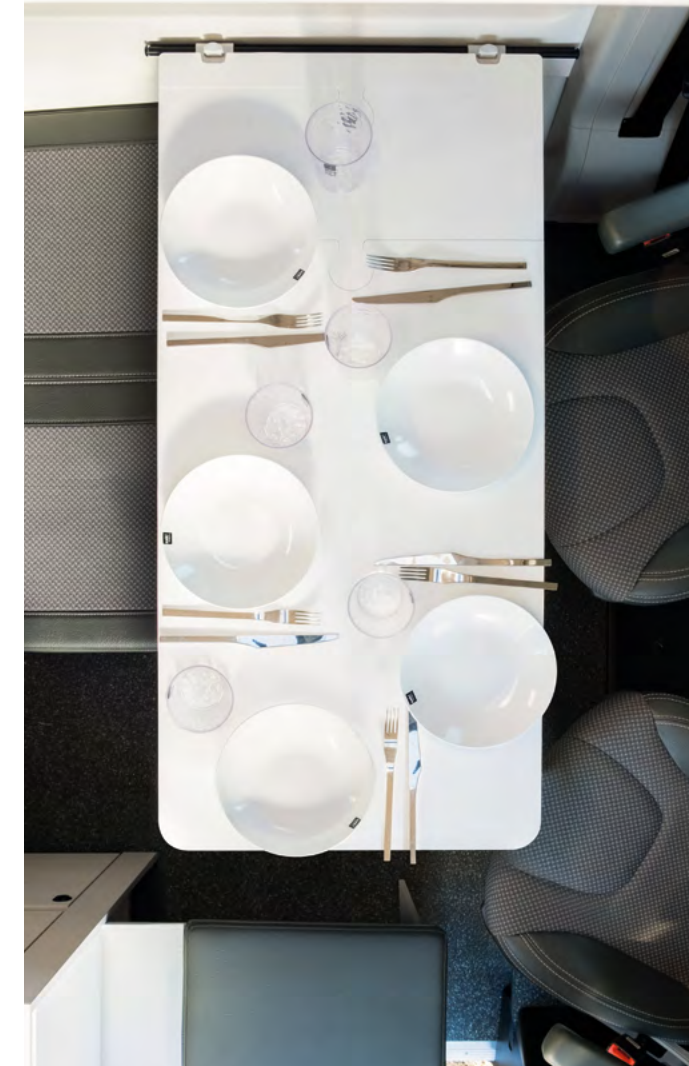
Generous wider passages

Tourne is designed for optimum access and mobility. Getting in and out is easy with the wide door passage the campervan provides. (A whole 73 cm on the 6.0 variant and 65 cm on the 6.4). Because a Tourne is meant to be used, outdoors and in, so nothing should stand in your way.



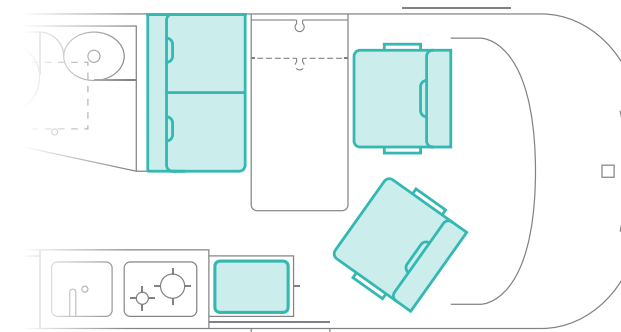
Convenient fold-away table

The generous mid-cabin table plays host to any number of uses: dining, reading, working, games, or securing that tricky fishing lure. And it can be easily folded down to allow for more room and more importantly, to fix up the second bed. Securing the table is fast, easy, and discreet. Even better, the table can be easily extended well into the cabin to ensure all five seated can make good, comfortable use of it.



Pull out a seat

The mid-cabin kitchen module features a handy pull-out seat whenever you need that extra seat. Even better, the seat doesn't occupy any volume in the kitchen space, so it's all function without the clutter.



Plenty of seats to go around

Swivel front seats opposite the 2-person bench together with the extra pull-out seat in the kitchen area combine to provide a spacious yet intimate mid-cabin common living area around the generous fold-away table.

KITCHEN & COOKING

What's Cooking?

The Tourne kitchen is a compact, practical, full-time working kitchen. It features a low-energy fridge, a proper gas stove with two burners, and a stainless steel sink—both of which can be covered with an elegant, fold-down glass lid and used as additional workspace when not in use. So you can prepare and cook or simply heat real meals, wherever and whenever. The kitchen even boasts a view, out the open door, or out the spacious window in front of the stove.

Cupboards up top and below are robust, good-looking and practical, and all feature easy locks that ensure things stay in their proper place.



Compact working kitchen

The Tourne kitchen features plenty of space, an extendable work countertop, numerous drawers for implements, adjustable shelves in spacious cupboards, hooks for hanging things, and electrical connections for household appliances. The slots on the top of the drawers serve as handles for opening/closing and at the same time as ventilation slots to ensure storage space stays fresh.



KITCHEN & COOKING

Upper cupboards

Cupboards above the stovetop allow easy access to food items, which are well secured for safe, clean travels. Alternatively, the cupboards can be used to store other often-used necessities.



Low-energy refrigerator

The low-energy refrigerator allows for longer autonomous stays off the grid. And it's positioned at waist-to-eye level, for easy sight and access. Better, the fridge installation doesn't require any additional cutouts in the outer walls of the vehicle, which reduces the possibility of water entering the interior and heat loss in cold weather.



Lower cupboards

A generous, shelved cupboard below the fridge provides plenty of storage for food and other essentials. Better yet, shelves are adjustable, even removable, in order to make use of the cupboard to hang and store clothing.



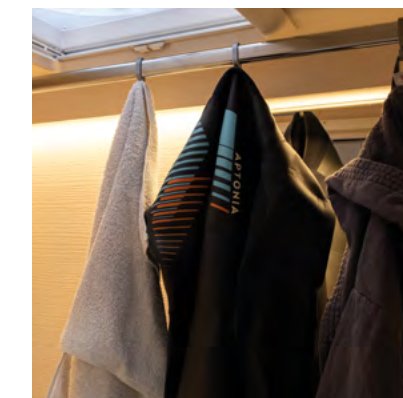
BATHROOM

Convenient, Flexible, Comfortable

The bathroom design with shower, comfortable toilet, and convenient cabinet is multifunctional. The choice of highly water-resistant fixtures and materials, together with well-considered details means it can be used without additional protective curtains.

The toilet is rotatable, which allows for more space and room to move when not in use, and the retractable shower hose and head remain tucked neatly away beside the sink.

A rod for hanging and drying larger items of clothing and heating system are integral to the design, which, in conjunction with the roof window with active ventilation, allows for faster drying.

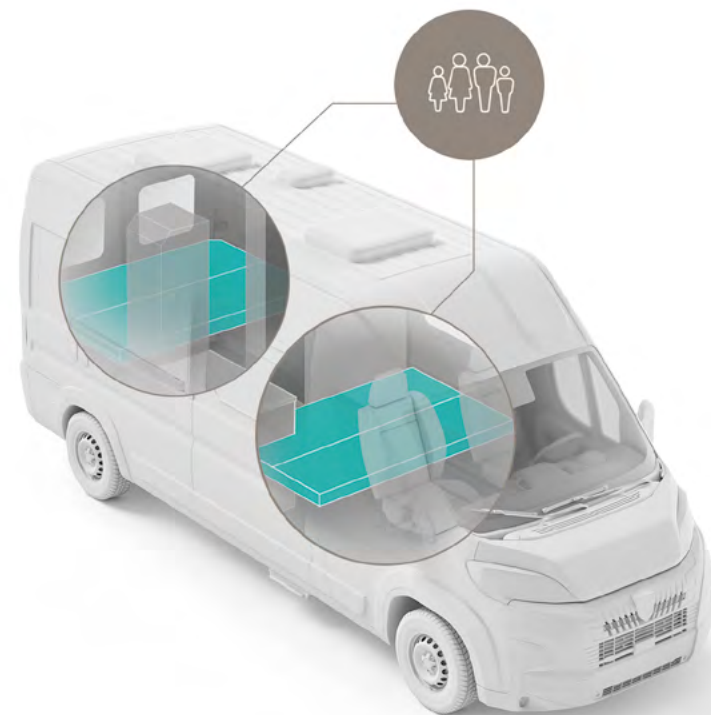


DREAM4SYSTEM

Tourne's Dream4 is a unique, patented design scheme that allows a standard van to sleep up to four people – inside the vehicle proper.

Two sleep rear-cabin on a generous, dedicated mattress system that folds away for storage of bigger items from floor to ceiling. Another two can sleep comfortably mid-cabin by folding away the cabin table, quickly and easily.

Second mid-cabin bed system

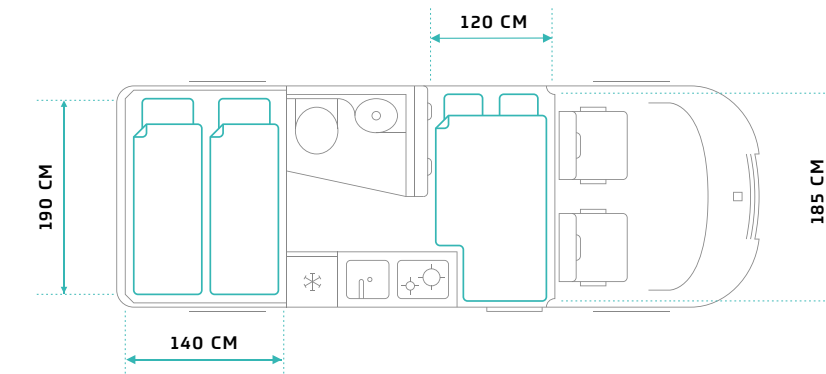

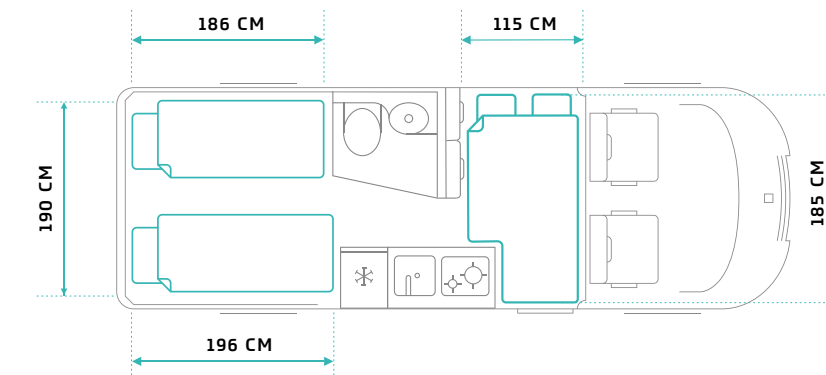
Tourne is available in 2 configurations: 6.0 and 6.4

As the numbers suggest, the two are 6.0 m and 6.4 m in length, allowing for different sleeping and storage configurations. In the longer 6.4, the rear beds are turned lengthwise, providing more space for an even more comfortable sleep setup. Similarly, there is more storage space at the rear of the van cabin. Different solutions, same great design.

The split mattress configuration allows you to split the bed into a single bed and take advantage of the extra space to store a bike or similarly large cargo.

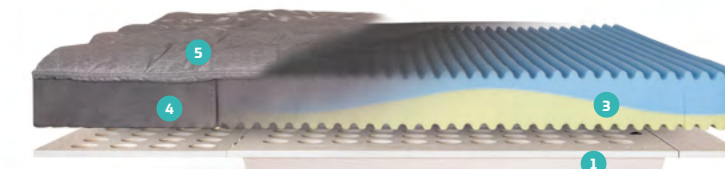
Rear-cabin bed system

Get a good night's sleep on a proper, giving yet firm mattress. A tried and tested bed system employs thick yet firm mattresses atop a flat, perforated base for excellent breathability. All pillows together with a thick topper

provide further, luxurious comfort. Mattress overlays are an integral part of the vehicle's equipment and are custom-made to precisely fit the bed and minimize storage space.

STORAGE & SPACE

Smart Storage, Organized Life

Practical, innovative design means more storage room everywhere: in the mid- and rear-cabin areas –under seats, beds, counters, and more. There's plenty of room for luggage, equipment, even bicycles.

The 6.4 boast an additional 36,5 cm of longitudinal storage space. With the rear doors open users enjoy good, wide visibility into the entire space, making loading, stowing, and unloading that much easier.

Whether you're packing for a weekend getaway or a long road trip, the ample, well considered storage spaces make it easy to keep your essentials close at hand while maintaining a tidy and clutter-free cabin. With the combination of practical design and smart use of space, you can travel with everything you need, neatly and effectively.

Flexible multipurpose cabinet

By stacking the shelves in the multi-purpose cabinet under the refrigerator, users gain more volume and can change the storage scheme, from hanging to shelved to free space. So store bags and larger gear, shelf food, clothing or smaller items, or hang clothing and similar, easily and effectively.

Discreet drawer under the bench

The discreet pull-out drawer under the bench provides yet more space, big enough for larger items, bottles, bulk food and more.



Wide aisles, plenty of space

Wide aisles and generous rear cabin space allow for more storage, much of it out of the way and out of sight. Under the bed users enjoy 66 cm of space for larger items across almost 100 cm of floor space transversally.

Movable barrier

Tourne features a movable barrier for easier access to items behind the barrier separating mid- from rear-cabin; and prevents cargo from moving around when in motion. Safer, easier, more convenient.





Cupboard space

There's plenty of additional space above the beds, for blankets, clothing, and personal items.

Open storage box

The open storage box below the bed provides yet more space for larger items that might be stowed for longer periods. Beside that, on the 6.4 variant, is an open-shelved unit for smaller items and gear.

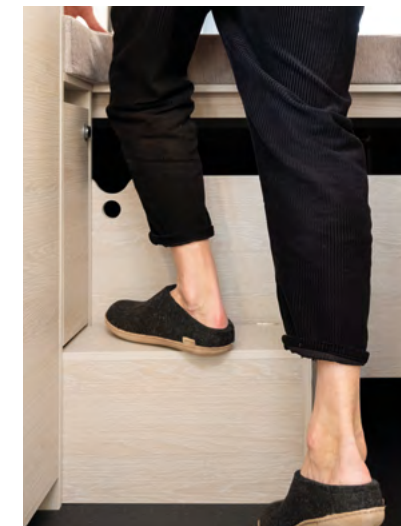


Open shelved storage

Under the bed on the right side of the vehicle (6.4) is another open, securely shelved storage unit – for footwear, essential equipment, accessories and more.

Pull-out drawer and step

The additional, handy, pull-out drawer and step on the 6.4 provides another discreet storage space that hides away, and even serves as a step to easier access the raised rear-cabin bed.



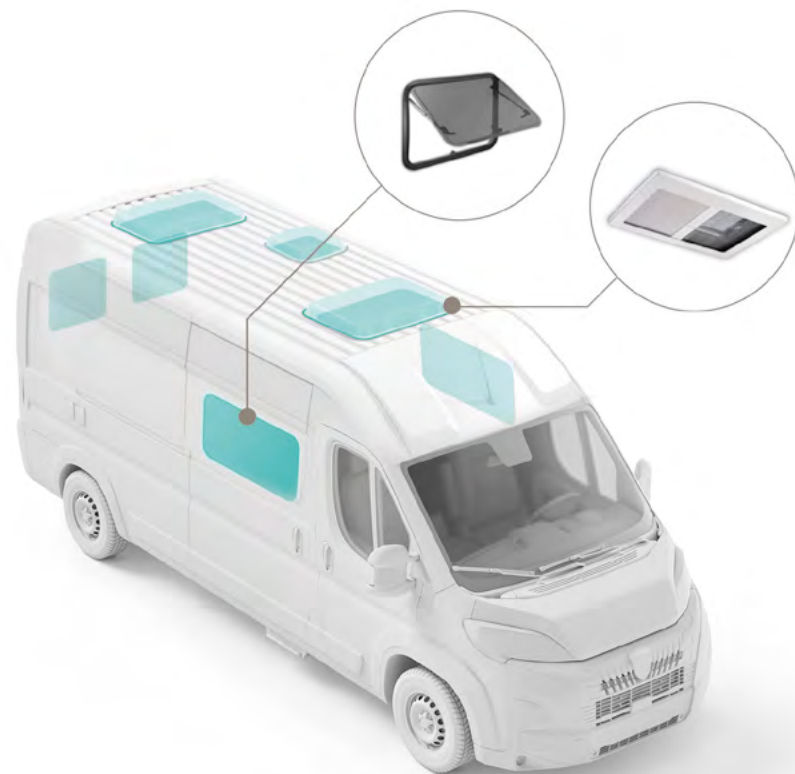
LIGHT & AIR

More Than Just Great Views

Tourne windows are double-glazed, keeping the cabin cooler when the sun starts to heat things up. The skylights above the rear- and mid-cabin areas – among the largest available in the industry – provide plenty of both air and light. And they also feature both a retractable sunshade and a bug screen to keep little flying things out. The third skylight, above the washroom cabin, provides crucial active air circulation and ventilation – and all very discretely.

Tourne does not offer a sunroof option, as the roof and side windows ensure plenty of light. Similarly, this ensures greater structural stability and safety. Further, the space above the driver has functional storage value.

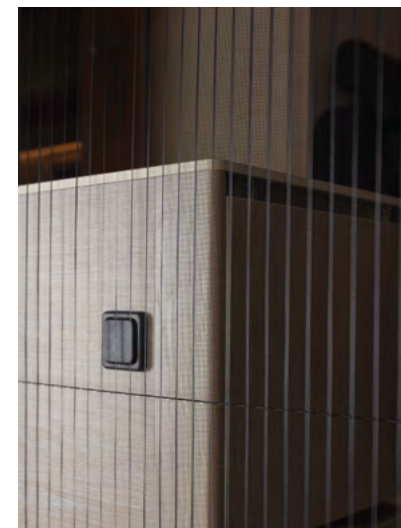
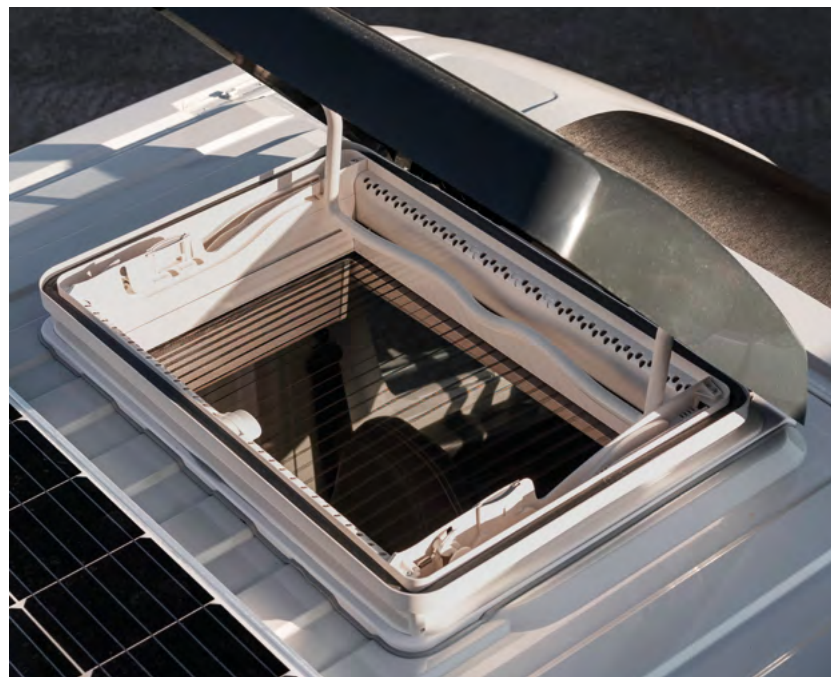
And the rooftop solar option provides enough power to run lighting, various accessory devices and more.



Shading & insect screens

Retractable insect screens keep the interior bright, fresh and well-ventilated – without any unwanted little visitors.

Similarly, retractable sunshades on all windows keep things cool by day and keep things suitably private by night.



Side windows

Tourne's windows are flush with the vehicle body, which makes the windows and the vehicle more aerodynamic, quiet, and better insulated.





CONNECTIVITY & LIGHTING

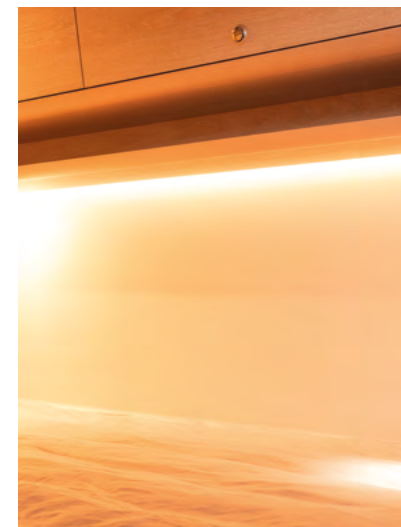
Well Lit, Well Connected

Tourne features an array of adaptive lighting solutions and configurations for different requirements, including several overhead cabin lights, kitchen spotlights, spot and reading lights rear-cabin, mood lights, and a (subdued blue) night light.

So users can always get the light they need without disturbing others and their specific lighting needs. In combination with all the natural light in the cabin the overall lighting experience is particularly convenient, pleasant, and efficient.

Generous and adaptive

LED lighting is bright, efficient, and effective; and is both easily accessed and where you most need it.



More connectivity

Tourne features numerous electrical outlets for connecting electrical devices in convenient places throughout the vehicle. Similarly, the camper boasts a number of USB connection points in the fore-, mid- and rear cabin areas.



OUTSIDE

The Great Outdoors Extended

External outdoor shower

Tourne's external outdoor shower is an efficient and convenient feature, which runs hot and cold, so users can make the most of a real, comfortable shower. It can also be used to hose down things that get a little dirty out in the great outdoors – bikes, boots, dogs, whatever needs a little cleaning up.

Expand your horizons

Extend and expand your horizons outdoors under the cover of the generous roll-out awning, which is otherwise neatly and discretely stowed away along the length of the rooftop.

Step up, step out

Tourne features an electric retractable step that helps with entry to and exit from the campervan, and even automatically retracts when the vehicle is started.



ALL-SEASON TECH

All Weather, All Season Campervan

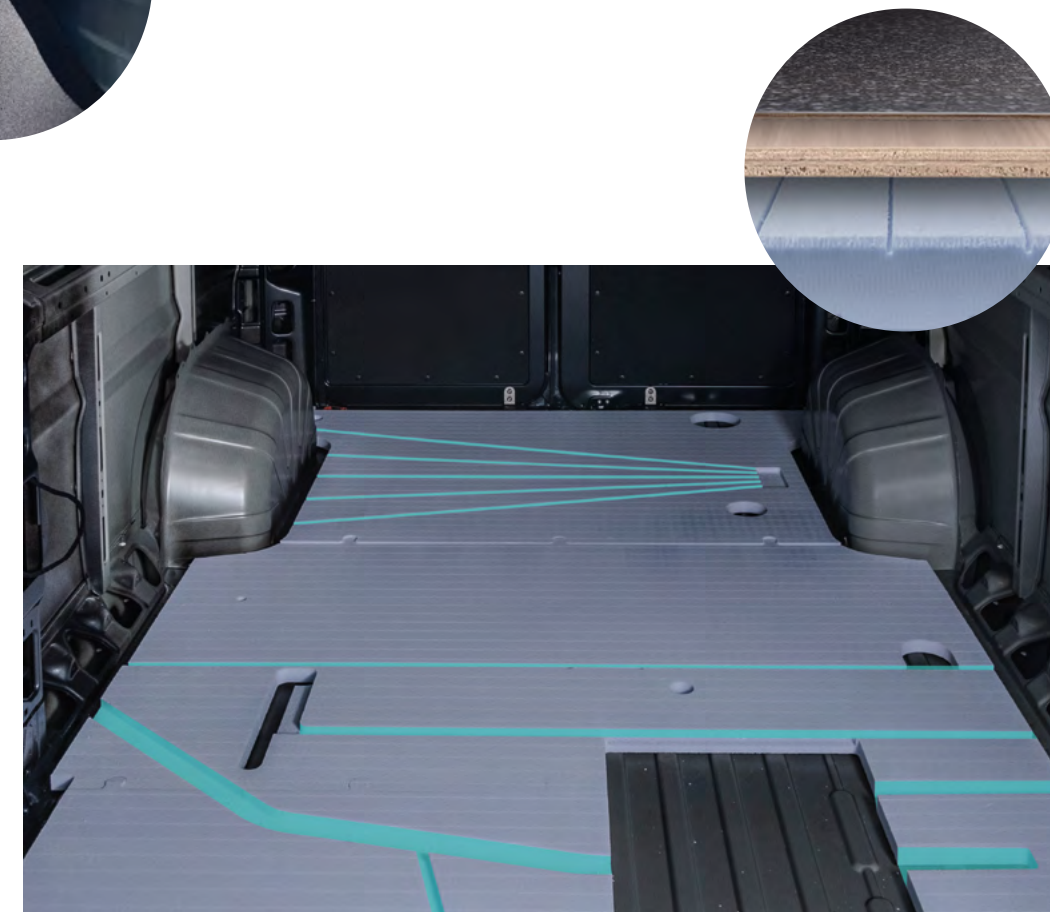
Tourne is ready to serve and perform in any and all weather conditions and seasons. The entire cabin is well wrapped in quality Armaflex insulation for quiet, stay-warm winters and cool, easy summers.

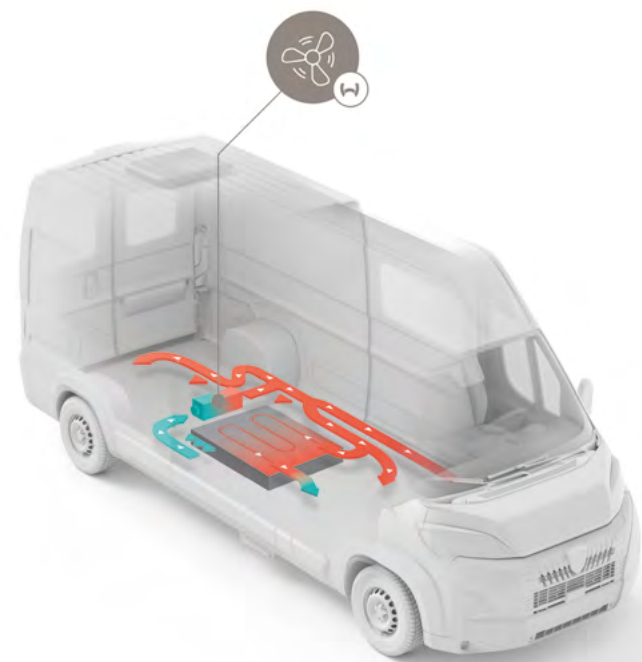
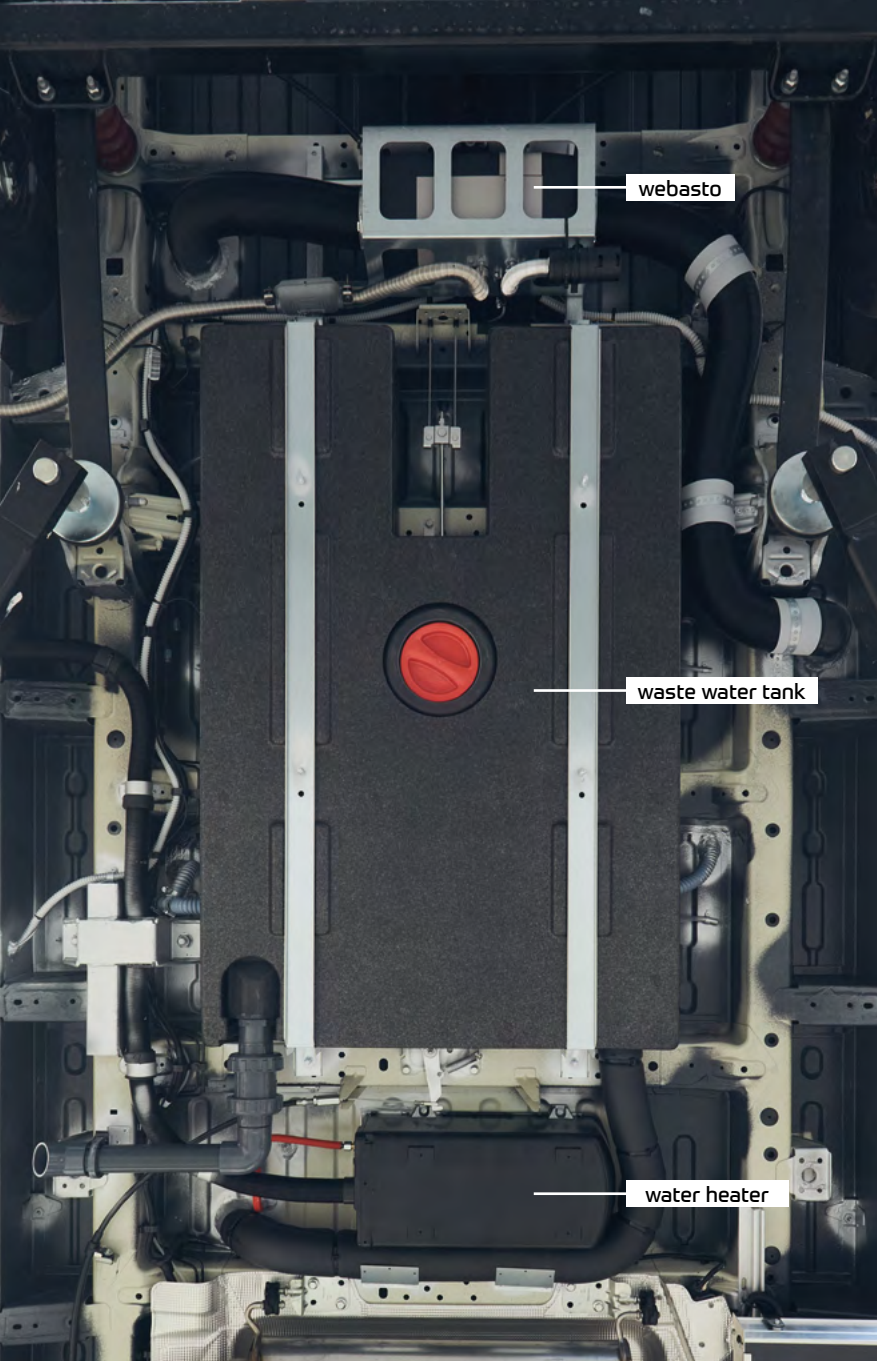
Tourne's heating system provides powerful heating while delivering good energy consumption, even at low outdoor temperatures. Air circulation diffusers are efficiently arranged so temperature differences inside are minimised. In order to heat the entire vehicle evenly, warm air is additionally routed to the floor of the vehicle and at the same time heats the water pipes, which are built into the thermal insulation.

Tourne does not offer a retractable roof, as these are incompatible with all-season vehicles, avoiding potential leaks and related issues.

**XPS insulation**

Additionally, 30 mm of XPS insulation is used for floor insulation for even more comfort year-round.





Webasto Air Top Evo

Tourne employs a Webasto gas oil air heater to heat the cabin, which boasts low fuel and electricity consumption. The automatic heating and operational system ensures a uniform, constant temperature.

Wastewater tank

The 100 l waste water tank is thermally insulated and heated with warm air; and an optional electric water discharge valve makes things that much easier.



ALL-SEASON TECH

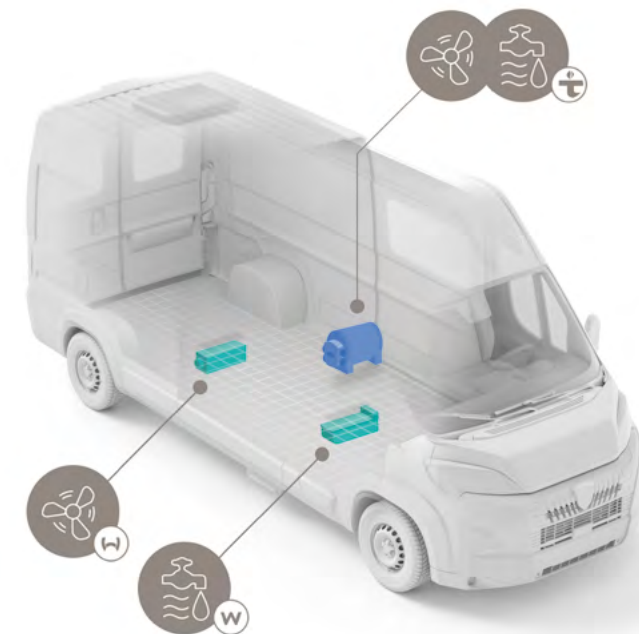
Water heating

A built-in Whale boiler with LPG heater is employed to heat hot water. But the device is installed on the outside of the vehicle proper, so it doesn't take up valuable space inside.

The LPG water heater is used in tandem with the diesel-powered Webasto for heating the air in the vehicle.

Truma Combi 6D

A hybrid device that runs on diesel, electric, or on mixed mode which combines the two to heat the cabin and produce hot water.

Floor heating

For even greater comfort, all models feature an electric heating foil on the floor as standard to ensure comfortable conditions inside, especially when outdoor temperatures get particularly cold.

In order to ensure everyone's safety, all vehicles have a sensitive gas detector installed as standard, which detects the presence of any gas in the vehicle cabin.



ALL-SEASON TECH

Fresh Water Tank

The fresh water tank, which has a capacity of 95 liters, is located inside the vehicle and is thus well insulated.

It also has a drain outlet to ensure water in the tank can always be refreshed and doesn't freeze up when the vehicle is left unused.



Central control panel

The Tourne CCP panel allows users centralized management of most all key functions in the camper. These functions include control of all internal and external lighting; battery charging – monitoring the condition of the batteries, including voltage and charging status; monitoring the water level in the tank, activation of the water pump and more.

The Tourne Select also displays battery voltage and current energy consumption, and can be controlled remotely via an application, which allows easy monitoring of the system's operation.

*In connection with the control unit, the vehicle's electrical system also has a built-in battery protection unit, which prevents excessive battery discharge and improves battery life.



ALL-SEASON TECH

Solar Power

Solar power provides an excellent source of clean, alternative energy that can be used to power various auxiliary devices in the vehicle. Both a single and a dual-panel configuration are available, delivering the power you need to remain independent of power sources off the grid longer and cleaner.

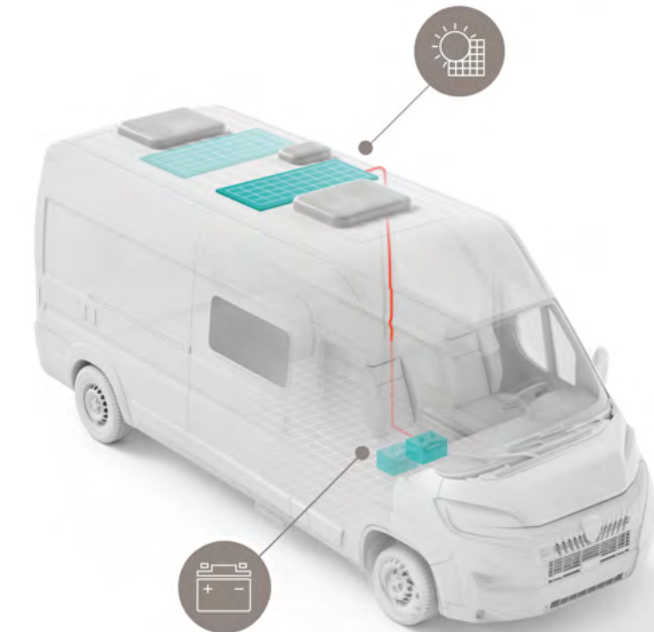

An optional auxiliary battery – charged via the alternator or solar – is available, ideal for those using an array of personal devices.

MPPT control

In combination with the built-in MPPT (Maximum Power Point Tracking) control technology, the system is more adaptable to different weather conditions, as the MMPT regulator adapts to different sources of sunlight.

With this technology, the vehicle is more energy autonomous, even in less favorable weather conditions, and the batteries charge optimally, thus extending their lifespan.

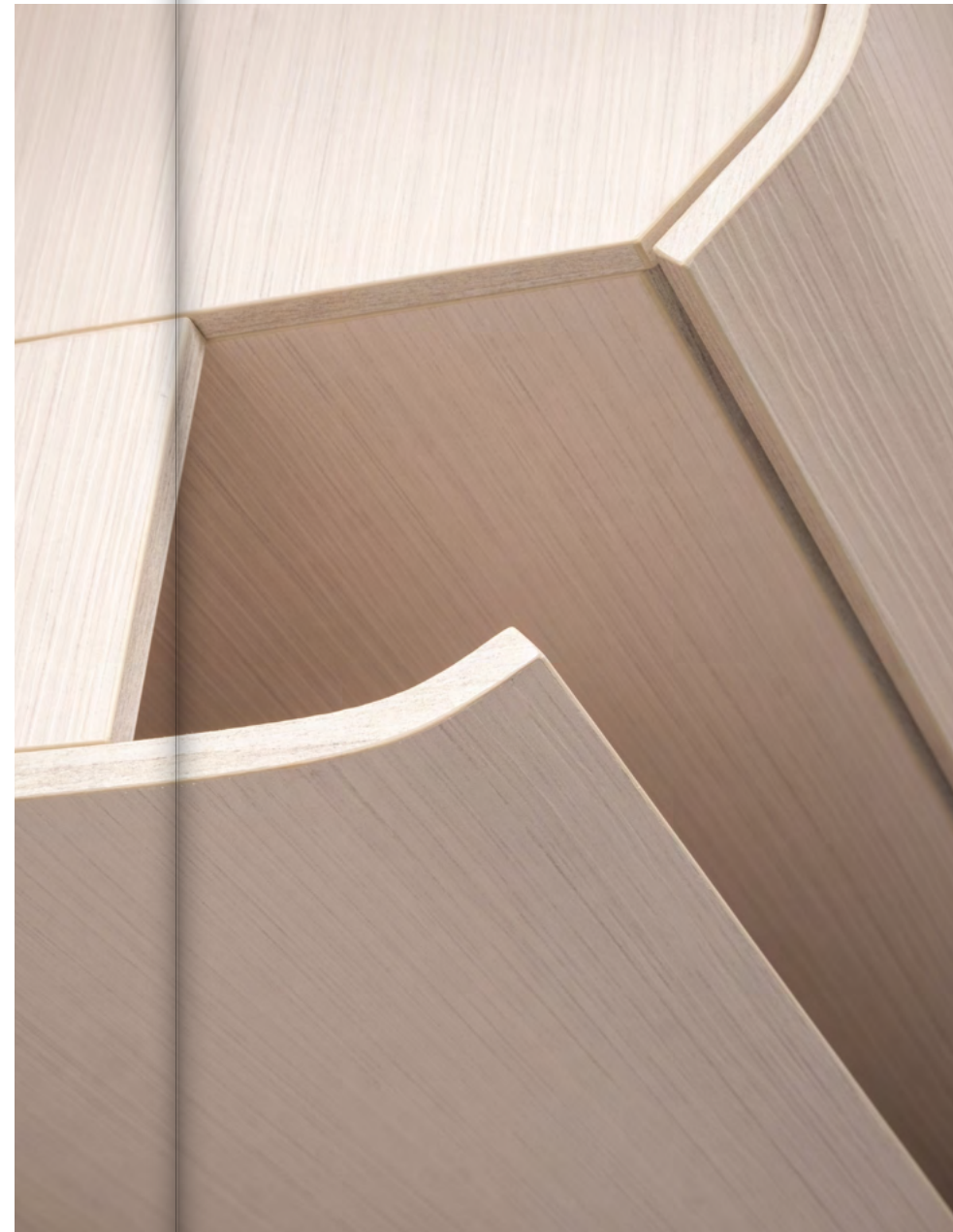


Quality & Materials

A Tourne is designed to last – and to retain its value, so there's no compromising in materials or workmanship. The camper's interior is typically exposed to plenty of wear and tear, so light poplar wood which is scratch- and impact-resistant, is used in interior construction.

Standard motorhome construction sees furniture components connected by assembly joints – but Tourne furnishings are fully glued, which makes for a more compact solution and reduces noise while driving. Similarly, drawer runners are soft closing, which is the standard in quality domestic kitchens.

Quality wood, naturally

In order to reduce damage and improve durability, sensitive wooden cores are covered on both sides with a thicker, extremely strong HPL laminate that is resistant to water and chemicals. Further, it is wear-resistant and easy to clean. And an ABS strip on panel edges is glued with waterproof glue for greater moisture resistance.

Similarly, a compact 10 mm HPL laminate is used for the table and kitchen counter. The edges remain covered as the material is the same throughout and completely waterproof. The rounded corners on the furniture are solid wood or curved plywood with a hard HPL laminate.



Solid, insulated underfloor

The underfloor is a sandwich construction consisting of a floor covering, a wooden core, and thermal insulation on the underside. The foam-vinyl floor covering is extremely durable, comfortable, and pleasant to the touch. On the top side it has a highly wear-resistant layer for easy cleaning. The wooden part of the floor is made of waterproof plywood. The thermal insulation on the floor has a strong, closed-cell structure suitable for the heavier loads the vehicle is likely to carry.

Strong, and easy clean

The ceiling, wall coverings, and other elements in the bathroom are all made of ABS thermoplasatics, which boast excellent tensile properties that are pleasant to the touch. The upholstery fabric is washable and highly wear-resistant, which simplifies cleaning. And adhesives, sealants, and foils are all selected and installed strictly according to manufacturers' instructions.



Quality foils

Tourne employs only the highest quality body foils, which not only look good but also boast a long service life. These foils are precisely cut out around the windows, which don't allow for any leakage or build-up of moisture.





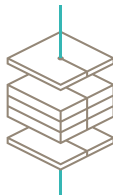
